

129 - Active-Force-Directed Organization vs The Holy Spirit (Part 1)

Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the Spirit of God was hovering over the waters.

Now the earth was formless and desolate, and there was darkness upon the surface of the watery deep, and God's active force was moving about over the surface of the waters.

And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever— the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept **him**, because it neither sees **him** nor knows **him**. But you know **him**, for **he** lives with you and will be in you.

And I will ask the Father and he will give you another helper to be with you forever, [**God's active force**] of the truth, which the world cannot receive, because it neither sees **it** nor knows **it**. You know **it**, because **it** remains with you

But when **he, the Spirit** of truth, comes, **he** will guide you into all the truth. **He** will not speak on **his** own; **he** will speak only what **he** hears, and **he** will tell you what is yet to come. **He** will glorify me because it is from me that **he** will receive what **he** will make known to you. All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what **he** will make known to you."

John 16:13-15 - New International Version

However, when **that one** comes, [**God's active force**] of the truth, **he** will guide you into all the truth, for **he** will not speak of **his** own initiative, but what **he** hears **he** will speak, and **he** will declare to you the things to come. **That one [that thing]** will glorify me, because **he** will receive from what is mine and will declare it to you. All the things that the Father has are mine. That is why I said **he [God's active force]** receives from what is mine and declares it to you.

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans.

In like manner, the spirit also joins in with help for our weakness; for the problem is that we do not know what we should pray for as we need to, but [God's active force] itself pleads for us with unuttered groanings.
